Population


Tables are presented on the population of the State by Health Services Executive regions. Comparison of Ireland's population with the population of other EU27 countries is also made. Preliminary results from the Census of Population conducted in 2011 recorded a population of 4,581,269 persons on census night, an increase of 8% over the 2006 population. Intercensal population estimates are also included in Table A2.

Definitions

- The young dependency ratio refers to the number of persons aged 0-14 years as a percentage of those aged 15-64 years.
- The old dependency ratio refers to the number of persons aged 65 years and over as a percentage of those aged 15-64 years.
- The total dependency ratio is the sum of the young and old ratios.






